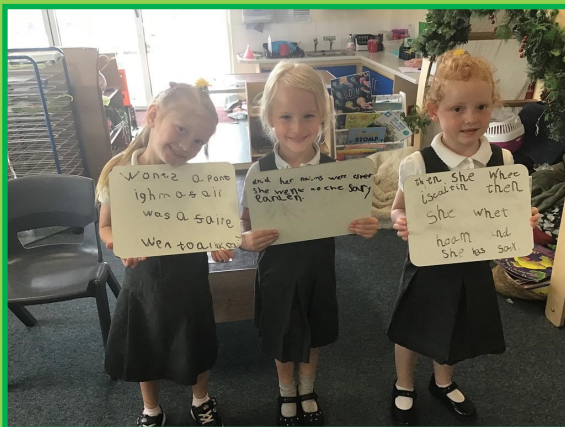


Our learning this week...Early Years

Our Learning This Week.....Class 1

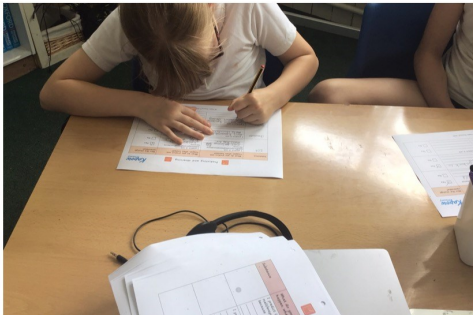
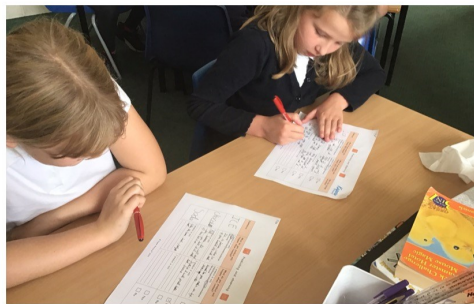
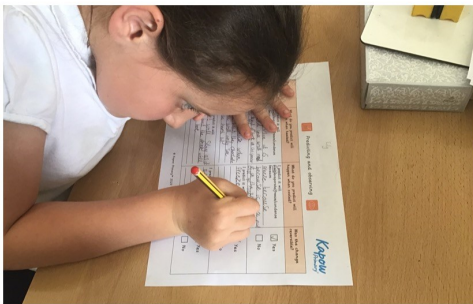
We have been very busy making jam sandwiches this week following our reading of 'The Lighthouse Keepers Lunch'. We are now ready to write our own set on instructions next week.

Our Learning This Week.....Class 2

Another great week in Class 2. We have continued learning about oceans in geography, focusing on how to look after our oceans and the impact of littering. In science we looked at reversible changes with materials and heated up some materials and substances to see how they change state. Children are at the planning and drafting stage for their narratives, it will be great to see what they produce next week. In music we are currently looking at Rock 'n Roll, with the children learning to sing Rock Around The Clock by Harry Nilsson. Have a lovely weekend!





PE Days and Kits

On PE days (Wednesday and Fridays) children will come to school in their PE kit and remain in their PE kits all day.

PE kit is a white t-shirt, black shorts and plimsolls or trainers for outside. As the weather gets colder, children can wear their school sweatshirts over their t-shirt—NO hoodies, or branded clothing. Just the school sweatshirt or a school fleece.

Forest School Days

On Forest School day (Thursday) children are to come to school in their uniform but ensuring that they have their arms and legs covered. As we move into Autumn and Winter, this shouldn't be a problem as the boys will be wearing trousers and jumpers and the girls wearing trousers or tights.

Children may bring an extra sweatshirt/fleece to add as an extra layer when it is cold. They will also need a weather appropriate coat.

No jewellery is to be worn on PE, Forest School or swimming days. If children are able to take out and put back in earrings on their own they may do so. If they are not able to, they should not wear earrings to school on these days. Taping over earrings is not permitted.
